



## Land Stewardship Intern

**Reports to:** Land Stewardship Manager

### **Position Summary:**

The Land Stewardship Intern will assist with various land stewardship projects, including general grounds and maintenance support. This includes habitat maintenance, restoration projects, and leading volunteer groups. This 20 hours per week position includes interaction with other staff, volunteers, parents, youth, visitors, and the outdoors. The internship period runs May through August of 2024.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Survey for invasive plant species
- Removal of invasive plants by cutting, pulling, or herbicide application
- Assist with habitat restoration projects.
- Help maintain grounds, trails and native plant gardens
- Work with volunteer groups on land stewardship projects
- Assist in the maintenance and storage of land stewardship equipment and supplies

### **Qualifications:**

At least two years of college-level courses. Primary interest areas could include environmental science, natural science, biology, natural resource management, parks and recreation management or related field.

- Ability to identify or key out native and invasive plant species
- Positive role model in attitude and behavior
- Energetic, flexible and able to work independently
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Able to work effectively with all Blandford Nature Center staff and volunteers



### **Physical Responsibilities**

While performing the essential responsibilities of this job, the Land Stewardship Intern is regularly required to sit, stand, bend, or kneel for extended periods of time. The Land Stewardship Intern occasionally must be able to lift up to 50 pounds. The Land Stewardship Intern must also be able to work outdoors in a variety of conditions; including wet, brushy, muddy and steep off-trail surfaces.

**Compensation:** Interns receive a stipend of \$2,500 for the summer season.
